## **RDA Center and SADE CGTH Signed the Contract for the Construction of the Chișinău-Strășeni-Călărași Water Main**

Ialoveni, September 30, 2024 – The Regional Development Agency (RDA) Center and the French company SADE Compagnie Generale de Travaux d’Hydraulique signed a construction contract today to build the Chișinău-Strășeni-Călărași main transmission pipe. This marks a significant step within the project “Water supply and sanitation in Moldova Center” one of the largest infrastructure projects in the field of water supply and sewage in the country.

The project works involve the construction of nearly 50 kilometers of main aqueduct, water pumping station in Tuzara and the renovation of several reservoirs. This project will bring direct benefits to over 30,000 residents of the cities of Strășeni and Călărași, as well as to rural localities connected to urban networks, ensuring access to safe and quality drinking water.

Through the implementation of this project, RDA Center aims to improve both the quality of the distributed water and the reliability of water supply in the central region of Moldova. The cities of Strășeni and Călărași, as well as other nearby localities will benefit from modernized infrastructure that will support regional development and contribute to improving the quality of life for the residents.

This project is being realized with the support of the German Government and the KfW Development Bank, with the total value of the works contract for the first phase being €22,090,604, funded as a grant. The execution period for the works is 21 months.
